WHY HOUSING MATTERS

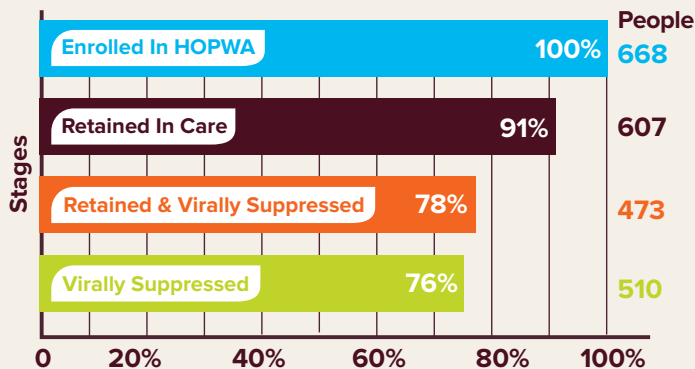
Own Home is one very important way we make sure our clients can stay in their homes by providing rent, mortgage, and utility assistance for HIV/AIDS affected individuals and families. Funding for **Own Home** by Housing Opportunities for People With AIDS (HOPWA), in partnership with the St. Louis City Health Department, found that the **Own Home** clients served by the grant **were 76% virally suppressed**. This means that HIV was undetectable in lab tests.

According to the National AIDS Housing Coalition, studies that examine the relationship between housing status to HIV prevention and care show strong correlations between improved health status and reduced HIV risk in the community, improved access to medical care, and better health outcomes. In addition, improved housing status is directly related to higher levels of adherence to treatment, lowered viral loads, and reduced mortality.

With more than 1,800 people served by **Own Home** annually, DOORWAYS makes a significant impact on individuals and families affected by HIV/AIDS. See our results below:

Definitions

- Enrolled in HOPWA:** Total unduplicated clients enrolled in the St. Louis metro program.
- Retained In Care:** Total unduplicated clients with two verified medical visits.
- Retained In Care and Virally Suppressed:** Total unduplicated clients with two verified medical visits whose most recent viral load results indicate suppression.
- Virally Suppressed:** Total unduplicated clients with viral loads less than or equal to 200 copies per ml.

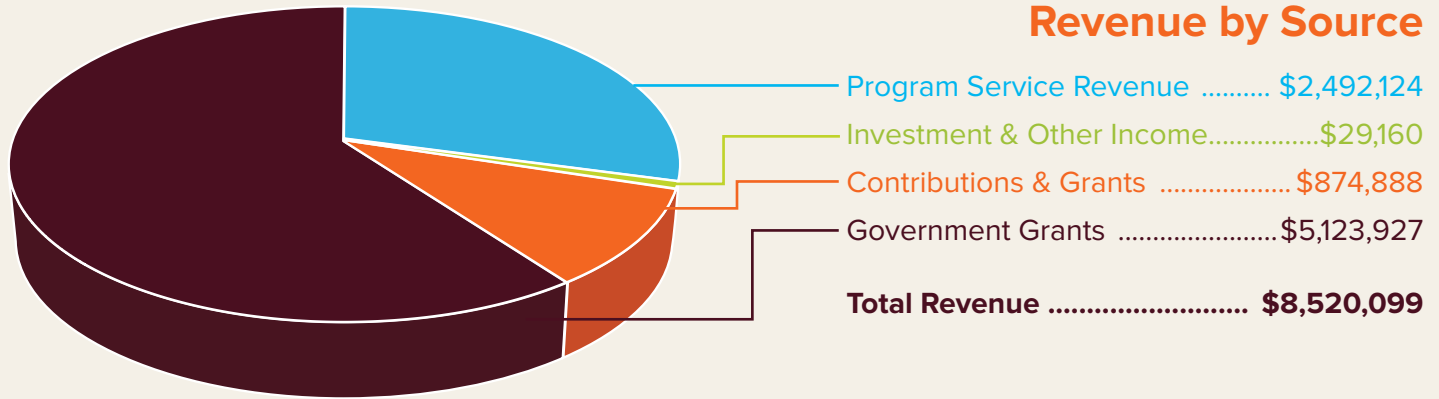
COMPREHENSIVE PROGRAMS

Cooper House provides **36 beds** for clients whose HIV-related illnesses require **24-hour healthcare**...**Jumpstart** improves the lives of single parents and their children...**Outstate** services provide housing and housing assistance for people in **62 rural counties in Missouri** and **55 counties in Illinois**...**Residential** provides **affordable apartments and supportive services** for low-income individuals and families ...**Own Home** provides, **emergency housing, rent, and utility assistance**.

In 2016, more than 2,900 people were served, including 1,700 clients and 1,240 family members.
