St. Louis, MO – Regions Bank is sponsoring DOORWAYS at PrideSTL's PrideFest 2017. Regions employees will march with other DOORWAYS supporters in the parade.

DOORWAYS is honored to be involved in PrideFest for the third year. The annual Pride celebration, a tradition since 1980, serves as a space of safety and empowerment for the LGBT community. This year, PrideFest will take place on Saturday, June 24th and Sunday, June 25th.
