DOORWAYS AWARDED NAP CREDITS FROM STATE OF MISSOURI

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE – In February, the Missouri Department of Economic Development announced that DOORWAYS is among 31 nonprofits across the state to be approved for a total of \$4,648,846 tax credits under the Neighborhood Assistance Program (NAP). DOORWAYS was awarded \$25,000 in its first ever NAP allocation. NAP helps nonprofit organizations raise private-sector funds by providing partial state tax credits to businesses that make contributions to approved community improvement projects.

Businesses can donate cash, materials, supplies or equipment; technical assistance and professional services; labor; real estate; or stocks and bonds. Credits can equal up to 50 percent of the total amount contributed.

Nonprofit organizations participating in the NAP program conduct capital campaigns or provide services in the areas of crime prevention, education, job training, physical revitalizations or community services. NAP is utilized by nonprofits throughout Missouri to make their communities a more desirable place to live and work, as well as pave the way for economic development.

“Economic development plays an important role in our community. But programs like this – where nonprofits and businesses join together to improve our neighborhoods – are vital to our future,” Senator Jamilah Nasheed said. “I was proud to support DOORWAYS’ application for this program.”
